**INDIANA MEMBERS CREDIT UNION CONTRIBUTES \$1,053 TO
FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP EDUCATION FOUNDATION**

The partnership allows Franklin Township School District supporters the opportunity to show their school spirit and support the foundation by signing up for a Franklin Township Education Foundation debit card. Every time the card is used as a signature based transaction, Franklin Township Education Foundation benefits. The more cards that are in use, the larger the contribution. Since beginning the program in 2013, Franklin Township Education Foundation has earned \$16,306.08 through this IMCU giveback program. In 2024, IMCU has contributed over \$127,000 through community initiatives, including its Affinity Giveback Debit Card Program.
